Bill lettered three years in wrestling and football at Muncy High School. In his junior wrestling year, he compiled a 13-3-2 record while winning the Sectional Tournament. His stellar junior year helped Muncy to finish at 10-1-1 and to win the West Branch Wrestling Championship.

A year later, wrestling at heavyweight, Bill posted a 23-1-1 record and won Sectionals, Districts, Regionals and finished third at States While anchoring Muncy's undefeated season at 12-0 by earning an electrifying decision to clinch the Championship over Bald Eagle Nittany by 21-18. The Muncy mat men that year also captured the District IV crown.

On the grid iron, Bill played fullback on offense and linebacker on defense. He was selected to the 1st team West Branch Conference team both offensively and defensively. He was co-captain his senior year.

Bill also competed in football and wrestling at Mansfield University while earning a letter in football.
