Denny was a four year letter winner in football at Muncy High School from 1958 to 1961. He served as Co-captain in 1961. Denny quarterbacked and then moved to fullback his senior campaign. The move proved beneficial as the Indians upset perennial powerhouse Bald Eagle Nittany 27-7 in the Indians' season home finale and spoiled the Panthers perfect season. Denny also competed in football at Lycoming College where he lettered four years. Denny served as Co-captain his senior season and ended his career by being named to the MAC All-Star second team in 1965.

Denny lettered three years in basketball at Muncy High School. He Co-captained the 1962 squad. During his junior campaign the Indians put together a dream season as they won the West Branch Conference Championship, captured the District IV Class C title and reached the final four (Eastern Finals) where they lost to a tough West Reading team led by Ron Krick, 72-49.

Denny coached football and basketball at his Alma mater Muncy High School during the 1966-67 seasons. He also coached at Bensalem High School where he coached football, wrestling and golf from 1967 to 1972. Denny also took his expertise in the sports field to Bensalem and Council Rock High Schools where he served the two school districts for thirty-one years as their Athletic Director.

Denny's dedication and commitment to sports and to young athletes also earned him the Lifetime Achievement Award-Suburban 1 League in 2002, the Bucks County Courier Times Long Service Award in 2003 and to complete the hat trick a lifetime membership in the Muncy High School Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.
