Sonny had the distinction of being a key performer on both football and basketball's inaugural seasons. Sonny was a running back and served as the team's captain in the Indians first year on the gridiron (1926).

Sonny also started on Muncy's first basketball team started by Ernie Brant (1926). The first year they played a non-league schedule and the second year they competed in the West Branch League along with Hughesville, Montoursville, Picture Rocks, Watsontown and South Williamsport. The first year they finished at 5-5. The starting line up for the last game on March 11, 1927 consisted of Grant “Sonny” Taggart, Capt Clay Lee, Max Schoch, Linford Frey and Mark Hester. Substitutes were James Wagner, Ray Long, Leonard Hill, Ralph Feigles and Bud Irwine.

Sonny continued his athletic career at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia, Pa. He lettered in football and wrestling in 1932.
