Howard “Pete” Pewterbaugh

Pete lettered in football, three years 1943, 1944 and 1945 where he was a two way performer at tackle. He was team captain his senior year. He was a member of the first Muncy team to beat Danville in 1944.

Pete was a two year letter winner in wrestling and baseball during his junior and senior years. He was a state runner up in wrestling his senior year.

Pete competed in sports at East Stroudsburg University. Pete was a 4 year letter winner in football. He was a two way starter for 3.5 seasons at tackle and garnered Honorable Mention All-Pennsylvania his senior year. He was also named to the East Stroudsburg Football Hall of Fame in 1978. Pete also lettered his junior and senior years in wrestling and track where he threw shot put and finished second in the All-Pennsylvania Conference.

Pete coached 13 years of football at East Lycoming and Montgomery High Schools, 10 years of coaching wrestling and 12 years of coaching track at East Lycoming High School.

Pete also played football while he served in the Navy, playing tackle and full back. Pete is a member of the West Branch Valley Sports Hall of Fame.
