Leroy "Andy" Anderson

Andy lettered in football, basketball and track in 1928 and 1929. As a fullback on the Indians football team, Andy was regarded as one of the best ever in the West Branch Valley. He also won the County pole vaulting championship for two successive years. Andy played on the Penn State freshman football team in 1929, but then dropped out of school. Had he stayed in college, he was expected to be first team fullback at Penn State as a sophomore.

Andy was a fullback on a semi-pro barnstorming team in the 1930 era which played games throughout central Pennsylvania. Because he was virtually unstoppable, Andy was the chief attraction for the fans.
