

Muncy High School Athletic Hall of Fame Mike Gaydon Class of 1993 Induction year 2001

Mike is a natural athlete. He excelled in several sports including Little League Baseball, Jr high football, AYSO soccer and elementary basketball.

Mike lettered four years on the Muncy High School basketball team from 1990 to 1993. He was selected as Mid-Penn Most Valuable Player during his sophomore and senior seasons. In his junior year he was selected first team All-Star team. During his four years on the basketball team, Muncy won three Mid-Penn League crowns (1990-1992) and captured their first District title (1992) since 1961.

Mike scored a record setting 1672 points during his career. He led Lycoming County in scoring his senior year with 585 points which set a Muncy record. He was voted First Team Mid-Penn All Defensive team in 1992-93. He was selected to the Bloomsburg Holiday tournament team three years in succession and was voted by the District IV coaches to play in the annual All-Star Classic for seniors.

On the soccer field, Mike made his mark immediately as he was named Multi-county All-Star goalie his freshman year. He was named First Team West Branch All-Star his sophomore, junior and senior years.

Mike played two seasons of basketball for Lycoming College and lettered both years.

Mike then coached soccer at his alma mater Muncy, handling the jayvees in 1994 before taking over the head chores from 1995-1998. He coached basketball at Montgomery in 1995 and at Muncy in 1996 and 1997. He has been an AYSO referee from 1991 to present.
