

THE MUNCY HISTORICAL SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Muncy Historical Society scholarship was established to honor a Muncy High School senior with a \$1,000 award to assist with higher education expenses. As a community-oriented organization, the Muncy Historical Society wants to reward a Muncy High School senior based on the eligibility criteria outlined below.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for this award the following criteria must be met:

1. A graduating senior from Muncy Junior/Senior High School who will be attending trade school or college to further their education in the field of the Arts & Humanities with emphasis on arts & design, architecture & sustainable design, landscaping & horticulture technology, forestry, graphic design, digital humanities, heritage tourism, museum studies, archaeology, information technology & user support, or to pursue a field of history.
2. A good student who challenges themselves to explore new ideas, who loves to delve deep into multiple subject areas at the same time, and who has contributed to their school and to their local community.
3. Preference might be given to a student in need of financial assistance, but financial need is not a prerequisite.

Answer the following questions with two or three sentences per question. Do not put your name anywhere on your submission.

1. How will your chosen field of study prepare you to continue your community orientation toward Muncy, or in any other community where you might choose to live?
2. Give an example or two of how you've challenged yourself to explore new ideas? How you've delved into multiple subject areas at the same time?
3. How have you actively given back to your school and/or community? How are you "paying it forward"?
4. Preservation is defined as the activity or process of keeping something valued alive, intact, or free from damage or decay. What does "preservation" look like to you in your future endeavors and the 21st Century?
